RULES & GUIDELINES

BEFORE YOU START BUILDING YOUR SOAPBOX PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

The idea of this event is for everyone to have fun Safely, in the building of the Soap Box and in participating in the event

There are two stages to the event this year;

- A downhill road section, which will be timed and consist of two runs
- An off road section in the Community Garden which will be judged on performance

Neither section is compulsory, but overall position will be an accumulation of both sets of results.

The team will consist at a minimum of one driver, but there is no upper limit.

An overall 1st and 2nd place will be awarded for both adult and junior classes.

The scrutineer's decision on whether the cart is safe to participate and whether the driver capable of racing safely is final

A GUIDE TO SOAPBOX CONSTRUCTION

THE RULES & GUIDELINES FOR THIS EVENT ARE MANDATORY AND FORM PART OF THE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. SoapBox must be capable of being steered
2. Wood, Plastic or /and Steel chassis is permitted
3. Brakes - some form of braking is mandatory
4. Covers/body may be attached to the chassis, but should be preferably made of a soft material, (cardboard /soft plastics etc)
5. There should be no sharp edges or protruding features that could cause injury to either spectator or crew
6. Any cover/body must be firmly attached to the SoapBox & considered to be safe on inspection.
